



How our eBay consignment sales work:

- Ø We come to your location and offer free evaluation of your items to help you establish a realistic selling value, so that your item can sell quickly.
- Ø We photograph your item, develop a catchy description, and list them on eBay. We track the progress of your item throughout the auction period and address any questions any buyer might have.
- Ø We can provide you with a link to the auctions if you would like to track the progress yourself.
- Ø We usually take items that are at least \$100.00 in value, but we would be happy to take a look at everything you have.
- Ø We charge \$10.00 per item as the listing fee. This fee includes basic eBay listing fees charge.
- Ø Once the items sell we arrange for shipment and handling which the buyer pays. (Prices depend on size and who has possession of the items that are sold)
- Ø Once item is received by the buyer which usually takes between one and two weeks, we then mail you a check and invoice for the sales proceeds less expenses and our commission.
- Ø Ebay and PayPal charge final value fees that are explained on our contract and can be explained to you when we visit to see your items. These fees are only charged once the item sell.

- Ø Our commission fee is based on the items final selling price. (See chart below)
